

# St. Andrew's Crew Earns 3 Golds, 2 Silvers at Cooper Cup

The girls crew program, led by Coach Wilson Everhart '95, continued its stellar season this weekend with three Golds in three races at the Cooper Cup. The Women's Novice 8+ stroked by Charlotte Berl '17 set the tone early in winning its race by open water. The Women's Varsity 8+ was the only boat to race under 7 minutes on the windy 2000m course with a final time of 6:59.91 to win the varsity race. The Women's JV 8+ then finished a clean sweep for St. Andrew's with an 18-second victory in its race.

The boys also raced well with the Stotesbury Regatta now less than three weeks away. The Men's Novice 8+ and Varsity 8+ each captured silver on the day. The Men's JV 8+ had the misfortune of being hit by another boat three strokes into their race, resulting in an oar to the chest and a broken foot stretcher. The boys were unable to race after the collision, but the result did little dampen the overall mood of the program after winning the day. "Rowing is often about more than results," said boys Coach Lindsay Brown. "Many would have been angry and frustrated after being hit by another boat, but the boys were very good sports."
